The Associate will be responsible for providing analytical and research support for CAI's investment activities. In this role, the Associate will have primary responsibility for detailed financial analysis, modeling, and valuation work. Other tasks for this position include assisting in the evaluation of new investment opportunities, conducting due diligence on target companies, and performing industry research. The role also requires the provision of support for portfolio companies, which may include assisting in the arrangement of debt facilities, supporting merger and acquisition activities and working with senior management in the development of financial reporting packages. There is one position available in our Toronto office and one in our Vancouver office.

Qualifications:

- Undergraduate business degree required, CFA or CA an asset;
- Two to four years of relevant professional experience in a private equity firm, investment bank or accounting firm;
- Demonstrated ability to assess financial statements and to construct complex financial models using Excel;
- Direct experience in company valuation, with knowledge of standard valuation techniques including IRR assessment, discounted cash flow and comparable analysis;
